Supported Tenancies

We are registered with CQC to provide 24 hour support to people living in their own tenancies. We currently provide support Tenancies in Bury, Heywood, Bamford and Castleton.

How Much does it cost?

Weekly charges are agreed with and set up by local authorities, sometimes jointly funded with PCT's. Each person has a personal budget identified to meet their individual assessed support and care needs.

We embrace the personalisation agenda, Individual Service Funding and welcome people who manage their own budget and self-directed support.

Healey Care Ltd offer a wide range of support through a comprehensive network of residential care homes and bespoke supported living tenancies, respite and day support services.

Our aim is to ensure and promote the well-being of people we support and to deliver this support with dignity, kindness and respect. We will enable people to reach positive outcomes through self-directed support and by working in their best interest at all times. We encourage everyone to develop to their full potential and our dedicated support staff help to provide safe, stimulating and healthy environments. Individual Care packages are tailored to the needs of the person. We promote a positive behaviour support approach that will stimulate and enhance quality of life and enable those in our care to integrate and enjoy their local community and open up opportunities for personal development and wellbeing.

Residential Care

All the Care Homes have been extensively modified to accommodate people's individual requirements. Bedrooms are decorated to meet the choice and needs of the individual. Each house has a large communal area with kitchen, dining area, TV lounges and quiet areas, giving the homes a warm comfortable environment that people find stimulating and safe. All the homes are serviced 24 hours a day by qualified support staff to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the people we support.



Healey House was the first of our homes to open in 1997. Situated just off the main road in Whitworth overlooking Healey Dell and with easy reach of Rochdale. The house provides support for up to eight people.

The Bungalow was built in the grounds of Healey House in 2007, with accommodation for an additional 2 people.

Holt Mill House is situated in Whitworth, within easy reach of the local facilities and public transport. The home is registered for three people and is adjacent to our Day Service building at Holt Mill.

Woodleigh House was opened in 2000. Situated in the village of Waterfoot in Rossendale, it's a short walk to the village with all its amenities and a mile from Rawtenstall. The house has been extensively modified and caters for ten people.

Ravenswood is situated on the main road through Whitworth, within easy reach of Rochdale and the surrounding facilities. Ravenswood provides support for three people.

Respite

Healey Care Ltd provide dedicated respite provision at Woodleigh House and Healey House. Support workers ensure that people integrate well into their new community for the duration of their stay, and we welcome the opportunity to provide a transition period to help people settle in. The surroundings are welcoming and safe with 24 hour support and provide stimulating opportunities for people to try new opportunities.



Day Services

Holt Mill Support Services provide a comprehensive day provision based at Lloyd Street in Whitworth. We provide support to people who live at home with family or in their own home and wish to attend for the day or specific sessions.

A full range of activities are provided over the week. These may include visits from experts who assist with 'Cook and Eat sessions', gardening skills and basic woodwork, art and craft and life skills. Support staff make use of the beautiful countryside and the local environment around the centre for long nature walks.

Individual support is provided with specific skills to help with activities such as Gym, swimming, Aquafit, college and adult learning.
